# Frequently Asked Marriage License Questions:

**Q: Do we have to get our Marriage License before the ceremony?**

A: Yes!! California Law requires that a valid, legal license, issued by the County Clerk's office of any California county, be presented to the officiant prior to the ceremony.

**Q: When should we get our Marriage License?**

A: When purchased, the license is considered as a "Permit to Get Married" and is ONLY GOOD FOR 90 DAYS! It becomes a license once it has been filed after the ceremony has been completed. We recommend that you purchase your license approximately 30 - 45 days prior to your scheduled ceremony date.

**Q: Where and how do we get our Marriage License?**

A: You can purchase your license at the County Clerk's Office located in the county seat for any County. Check the County Clerk's website for the county you are going to. Check fees and hours that they are open. Price is different in each county! You need to appear TOGETHER. Bring a photo ID (Driver's License or Passport or both), know your parents' names and where they were born (State or Country), and bring either cash or a credit/debit card.

**Q: Don't we have to get our license in the same county that we are getting married in?**

A: No. The Marriage License can be issued in ANY county within California and you can get married in ANY county in California.

**Q: When do we sign our license?**

A: The two of you will sign your license only one time and that will be in front of the County Clerk when your license is issued. Following the ceremony, the officiant and your witness(es) will then sign your license attesting to the fact that there was, in fact, a ceremony.

**Q: How soon will we get a copy of our Marriage License?**

A: There are only TWO Counties in the Bay Area that will automatically send you a copy of your completed license. They are Alameda County and Napa County. For every other county, you need to wait 10 - 14 days to either go in person or send in a written request (which requires a notarized signature). Each copy will cost you \$15.00 to \$20.00, depending on the county.

**Q: Is there a way to get the certified copy of our license faster?**

A: Yes! If you bring the completed Request for Certified Copy form (provided either online or at the County Clerk's office), with the required notarized signature, and a check made out to the County Clerk for the number of copies that you want, to the officiant with the Marriage License prior to the ceremony, he/she will file the request WITH the license and you will get your Certified copy of your Marriage License in about 10 -14 days.

**Q: Can I wait to decide if I want to change my name?**

A: No. Due to the Name Equality Act of 2007, this is a decision that MUST be made prior to purchasing your Marriage License. If your new name is not on the Certified Copy of your Marriage License, you CANNOT use marriage as the reason for changing your name. The only way you could then change your name is by petitioning the court for a legal name change.

**Q: Can I start changing my name before I get married?**

A: No. Most agencies will require proof, in the form of a certified copy of your Marriage License, before they allow you to change your name.

- Photo ID with Name and Birth Date (Birth Certificates are NOT required or needed)
- If divorced, you'll need to know the date your previous marriage was dissolved
- Names (including Mother's Maiden Name) and Birthplace of Parents (State or Country)
- Cash, check, or Debit Card (Very few Counties accept Credit Cards – Check County Website First)

# Changing Your Name:

## Social Security Card:

Contact your local Social Security Office

### You will need:

Certified copy of marriage certificate with file number at top, (Current ID (mandatory), Proof of US citizenship or immigration status if not born in US (NOTE: Changing name on social security record without first changing name through immigration may cause problems with records not matching) If available, you may wish to bring your birth certificate, as well, in case any information other than your name is incorrect on SSA records

## Driver's License:

Contact your local DMV office. Inform them that you have changed your name and that you need their records to reflect the change.

## Federal Income Taxes:

Complete your tax return with your new name. Social Security will forward the information regarding your name change to the IRS. Confirm that the IRS has received this information.

## State Taxes:
